

Wheels 2 Work

Wheels 2 Work is an innovative moped loan scheme delivered by Inspira. It is for people who struggle to access public or private transport to get to work, training or learning. Inspira works with partners to establish the scheme and deliver it on their behalf.

The scheme provides a temporary loan of a modern, fuel-efficient moped with training, helmet and safety clothing.

Participants need to make a small monthly contribution, based on their level of income, which goes towards insurance, servicing and maintenance which is organised with a local W2W coordinator.

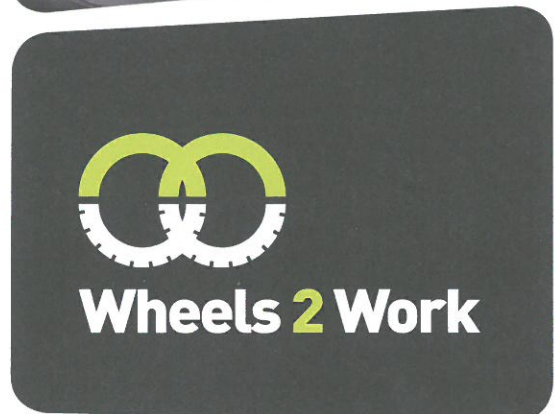
