### Course Overview

Led by local artist Marianne Lusby, this fun four-week introduction will introduce you to basic ceramic materials, techniques and processes. Using specialist tools and approaches you will produce a range of samples such as tiles and pinch pots. You will also explore different decorative techniques such as impressing and creating relief surfaces.

On completing the course you will be confident in using a range of basic ceramic techniques and processes and have a small collection of ceramic samples to take away.

The course will allow for the opportunity to develop skills working within a specialist ceramic studio to produce ceramic pieces.

This course is a non-assessed training programme, there is no requirement for you to produce a portfolio of work. Certification for participation can be provided on request.

This course could help you build a broad portfolio of work for access to higher level creative study or related career.
