Course Overview

This course is taught by Emily Younger, who established Folklore Children clothing, she has lots of experience working with textiles and is our sewing expert. Using hand stitch and sewing machines, you will be shown how to make simple repairs and personalise items of clothing.

You will learn:

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How to mend holes and rips.

- How to take in and let out trousers, dresses and skirts

- How to fit zips and buttons.

- How to personalise clothing with patches.

Emily will deliver the course through practical demonstrations providing the opportunity to ask questions and take notes. You will then be observed and supported practising the techniques covered within the session. There is no formal assessment or qualification linked to this beginners course.

A variety of clothing samples will be available for you to use, but you are encouraged to bring in your own items to work on.

Suitable for complete beginners or those who have a little experience.
