Educational grants for young people under the age of 25 who have lived in the Lakes Parish (including Ambleside, Grasmere, Langdale and Troutbeck north of Trout Beck) for at least four years.

CUMBRIA (CUMBERLAND)

The Mary Grave Trust

The Mary Grave Trust - Turn2Us

The Trust gives grants to children and young people aged 11 to 21 who were born in the old county of Cumberland. Grants are given to help them travel abroad for educational purposes.

LANCASHIRE / PRESTON

The Shepherd Street Trust

The Shepherd Street Trust - Turn2Us

Educational grants for young people under 21 years old who live within 50 miles of Preston Town Hall.

Grants are to pay for outfits, clothing, tools, instruments, equipment which will help to further education or entry into a profession, trade or calling.

James Bond/Henry Welch Trust

James Bond/Henry Welch Trust - Turn2Us

The provision of financial assistance for people with diseases of the chest and lung and to children with disabilities and other special needs living within the administrative district covered by Lancaster City Council.

The Rycroft Children's Fund

The Rycroft Children's Fund - Turn2Us

Grants available to children and young people in Cheshire, Derbyshire, Greater Manchester, Lancashire, Staffordshire, and South and West Yorkshire.

The Harris Charity

The Harris Charity - Turn2Us

The Harris Charity gives grants to young people under the age of 25 who live in Lancashire and need financial assistance. Priority is given to people who live in Preston District.

The Charity might be able to help you if you are in hardship or distress or if you need financial assistance to start a job or apprenticeship.

NORTH WEST

The Bowland Charitable Trust

The Bowland Charitable Trust - Turn2Us

Educational grants for young people who live in the North West of England and are on low incomes.

The Northern Counties Children's Benevolent Society

The Northern Counties Children's Benevolent Society - Turn2Us

Educational grants for children who are in need or have an illness or disability who live in the counties of Cheshire, Cleveland, Cumbria, Durham, Greater Manchester, Humberside, Merseyside, North Yorkshire, South Yorkshire, West Yorkshire, Lancashire or Tyne and Wear.

Priority goes to children whose parents have died.

The fund can only help with educational costs and can't give grants for clothes or equipment.

NATIONAL

Lawrence Atwell's Charity

Lawrence Atwell's Charity - Turn2Us

Grants are available for young people from low-income backgrounds, to help them gain vocational, accredited qualifications. The charity does not give grants for secondary education, university or postgraduate degrees or courses at a private dance/drama college.

We offer grants from £100 to £1,500 for people aged 16 to 26, to take courses (up to level 3) that will help them move into employment. Funding can be given for course fees, equipment/materials, travel costs, and childcare. We also don't give grants for general welfare purposes.

The Vegetarian Society

<u>Search for charitable and educational grants - Turn2us</u>

Vegetarians and vegans aged below 26 who need financial assistance, such as help with educational courses or essential items.

Buttle UK

Buttle UK - Turn2Us

Grants for children aged 18 or under living with parents or carers, or young people aged 20 or under who are living independently, are estranged or orphaned. Grants are available to pay for essential household items such as furniture and kitchen equipment, clothing, white goods and bedding.

Always Look on the Bright Side of Life Charitable Trust

Always Look on the Bright Side of Life Charitable Trust - Turn2Us

One-off grants for activities/items/trips that children's families are unable to afford. The child must be disadvantaged due to financial circumstances, disability/ill-health, or another type of disadvantage. Poverty alone is not usually enough to be able to apply.

The Family Holiday Association

The Family Holiday Association - Turn2Us

Grants for struggling families in the UK who have a child or children under the age of 18 for a short trip, group trip or a day out. It may be a simple day out or a few days in a caravan at the British seaside.

SEDBERGH

Sedbergh United Charities
