

Student Transfer Arrangements

All providers of higher education in England are required to publish student transfer arrangements in accordance with the Higher Education Research Act 2017 and Office for Students Regulatory Framework 2018. The purpose is to facilitate the continuation and quality of study for all students whenever a risk to their continued study occurs and to facilitate transfer between providers.

Kendal College will establish arrangements for students to transfer between providers, as well as making arrangements for students transferring out and for those transferring into Kendal College.

If you've changed your mind about a unit, a course or even your place of study, please talk to us. We can help you transfer:

- Within the College, for unit, course or mode of study changes.
- Outside the College if you decide Kendal College is not the right place for you, we want to ensure that you make an appropriate choice for your next steps, and our staff are here to help you understand your options and answer any questions you may have about leaving the College.
- Into Kendal College if you are currently studying elsewhere we recognise prior and experiential learning, so you may be able to transfer directly into an appropriate programme of study or you may be exempt from specific unit.
